CONCRETE POUR: Following months of piling and excavation subterranean work, one of the tallest towers in Edgewater has officially gone upward. Vertical construction of Miami's Elysee condominium is officially under way following completion of the concrete foundation pour June 15. Construction of the 57-story waterfront tower began in December. About 75 construction workers poured the foundation. The 100-unit project is being developed by Two Roads Development in partnership with entities managed by New York-based investment firm DW Partners. The 648-foot-tall tower is expected to open in 2020.
